Ephesians 6:18 With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints, 19 and pray on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel, 20 for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in proclaiming it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.



Prayer is dependence on The King.



Prayer is also petition for one another's perseverance.



Prayer is asking for boldness in proclaiming Christ.

Ephesians 6:21 But that you also may know about my circumstances, how I am doing, Tychicus, the beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, will make everything known to you. 22 I have sent him to you for this very purpose, so that you may know about us, and that he may comfort your hearts.

- Paul refers to Tychicus as a beloved brother which he uses as a common phrase in his letters to the recipients (church).
- Paul refers to Tychicus as a faithful minister in the Lord and also had addressed the recipients of this letter as faithful.
- Paul is affirming, comforting and encouraging his fellow workers outside of prison while he is suffering.

Ephesians 6:23 Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. 24 Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ with incorruptible love.

- Love, grace and peace come from God and are to be increasingly embodied through relationship with Him.
- The love, grace and peace that we receive from Him are available as we live out the newness of life in Christ.
- The readers of this letter need this benediction and blessing from Paul and from one another.

Ephesians 1:1-3

- 1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are at Ephesus and who are faithful in Christ Jesus:
- 2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 3 <u>Blessed</u> be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has <u>blessed</u> us with every spiritual <u>blessing</u> in the heavenly places in Christ,

Ephesians 4:1 Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,

Live out your calling with the story of redemption in mind.
