- 1. Abram rescued Lot and brought him back.
- 2. God & His covenant family came together against the kings.

- 1. Melchizedek is identified as king of Salem & priest of God.
- 2. Melchizedek blessed, affirmed & congratulated Abram.

- 3. Melchizedek also connects Abram to God Most High.
- 4. Melchizedek identifies God as King of creation.

- 5. Melchizedek blessed, affirmed & congratulated God.
- 6. Melchizedek affirmed where victory comes from.

Allegiance to God through Man

- 1. Abram showed his allegiance to God.
- 2. Abram did this by giving a tenth to God's representative.

Genesis 14:21 The king of Sodom said to Abram, "Give the people to me & take the goods for yourself." 22 Abram said to the king of Sodom, "I have sworn to the Lord God Most High, possessor of heaven & earth, 23 that I will not take a thread or a sandal thong or anything that is yours, for fear you would say, 'I have made Abram rich.' 24 I will take nothing except what the young men have eaten, & the share of the men who went with me, Aner, Eshcol, & Mamre; let them take their share."

Allegiance to God, not Man

- 1. Yahweh adds to the distinction of God being Israel's God.
- 2. God created people for His glory & His people for His glory!

PRACTICING AFFIRMATION

- 1. Good affirmations are God-centered, pointing to the image of God in a person.
- 2. When we commend God's image in people, God is glorified.
- 3. When done well, affirmation does not fuel pride in the person, but refreshes them and honors God.
