Psalm 89:15

How blessed are the people who know the joyful sound!

1. The good news is a joyful sound about the great God.
2. In worshiping Jehovah, people blew trumpets & shouted.
3. We are invited to journey deeper into the greatness of God.
4. Knowing & seeing God propels us to walk in the light.

The Holy, Creator God

Psalm 89:16 In Your name they rejoice all the day,
And by Your righteousness they are exalted.

17 For You are the glory of their strength,
And by Your favor our horn is exalted.

1. The Holy One of Israel is the all-sufficient source of joy every hour every day and every day every year.
2. Righteousness & strength are connected to His name.

The Holy, Creator God

Psalm 89:18 For our shield belongs to the Lord,
And our king to **the Holy One of Israel.**

1. God is one. There is no one like our God.
2. God is holy. No one or nothing compares to His glory.
3. The Holy One of Israel is our ultimate defender & shield.
4. Israel's Messiah is the King of kings.

Isaiah 6:1 In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple. 2 Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. 3 And one called out to another and said,

“Holy, Holy, Holy, is the Lord of hosts,

The whole earth is full of His glory.”

4 And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke.

Isaiah 6:5 Then I said, “Woe is me, for I am ruined!

Because I am a man of unclean lips,

And I live among a people of unclean lips;

For my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts.”

6 Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs.

7 He touched my mouth with it and said, “Behold, this has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven.”

8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, “Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?” Then I said, “Here am I. Send me!”

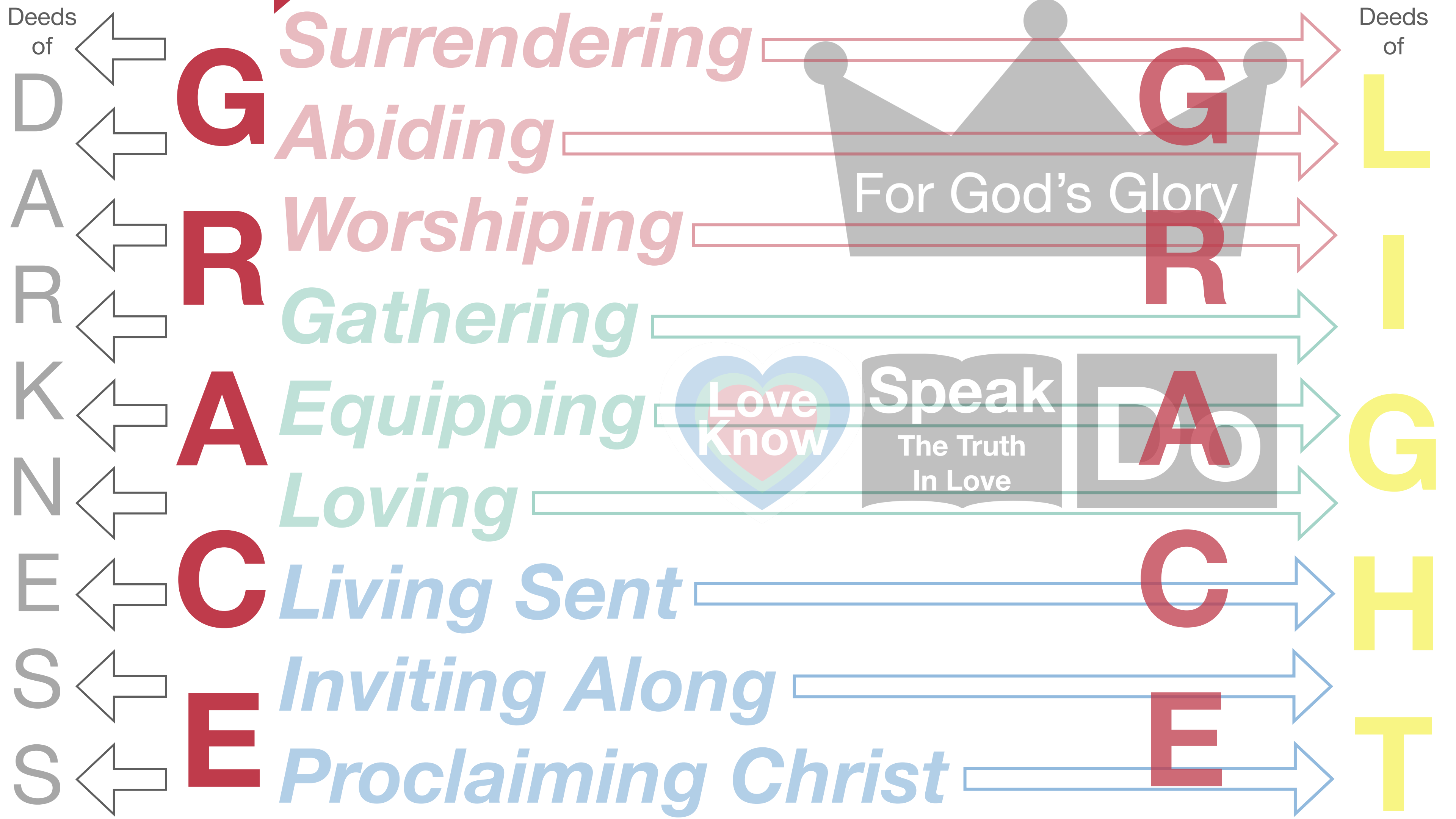
