

Grounded in the Gospel & Grace

Galatians 2:17 But if, while seeking to be justified in Christ, we ourselves have also been found sinners, is Christ then a minister of sin? May it never be! 18 For if I rebuild what I have once destroyed, I prove myself to be a transgressor. 19 For through the Law I died to the Law, so that I might live to God. 20 I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me. 21 I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly."

Galatians 2:17 But if, while seeking to be justified in Christ, we ourselves have also been found sinners, is Christ then a minister of sin? May it never be!

Point #1: Life in Christ is not a lawless life.



JUSTIFYING GRACE is the undeserved favor, free gift of God that pardons my sin and declares Jesus's righteousness as my own. I am saved for all eternity!



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SANCTIFYING GRACE is the undeserved favor, free gift of God that enables me to die to sin and live righteously day by day.

I am being saved daily!

By faith in Jesus Christ **justifying grace** declares us righteous and then by the work of the Word and the Holy Spirit **sanctifying grace** helps us reflect His righteousness.



Galatians 2:18 For if I rebuild what I have once destroyed, I prove myself to be a transgressor.

Point #2: Jewish Christians had lost their identity in the law. Their new identity was in Christ. And they were not to go back.

Galatians 3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"—

Galatians 2:19 For through the Law I died to the Law, so that I might live to God.

Point #3: Jewish Christians found their life in Christ as they died to the law.



Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Point #4: Jewish Christians were crucified with Christ, were no longer living for themselves, had Christ living in them and lived by faith in the Son of God.

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The holy, creator **GOD** was confronted with **MAN**'s rebellion and sin. So **JESUS** has given Himself in love to become the Redeemer and Restorer of man to God and God's purposes made possible by grace through faith and **SURRENDER** to the crucified, risen King.



Faith results in an initial surrender & an on-going surrendering marked by trust in & imitation of King Jesus for God's glory.

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Galatians 2:21 I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly."

Point #5: Don't miss the great grace of God because if righteousness comes through observing the law then Christ died for nothing.
