

## Phase 2—ReGathering In-Person-Guidelines

for Congregational Worship Services at 8:00 am and 11:00 am beginning June 7th

Be prayerful, humble and flexible.

Please do NOT feel any pressure to be here. Do what is safe for you.

THANK YOU FOR YOUR PATIENCE AND PRACTICE IN PHASE 1.

NO ONE with any symptoms should be in or stay in the Worship Center.

NO ONE with any health risks should be in or stay in the Worship Center.

There will be No Childcare and only the Worship Center will be Utilized.

We will utilize an FM Transmitter for those who want to be on campus but are vulnerable.

As we have experienced, the FM Transmitter signal will be available in the parking lot.

We will plan to continue using 91.1 FM. This is the “overflow plan” with limited space.

We will plan to continue to post a video of the worship service on the website though it will not be available on Sunday as it has been. There will be a delay. (FaceBook Live @ 11:00)

We have reduced our capacity by removing every other row of chairs.

Donnie Davis upgraded 2 new HVAC systems to include disinfectant systems in the worship center.

Doors will be propped open upon entering the Worship Center with your masks on.

**Please utilize the right set of double doors to enter the building.**

You will be able to select your seat and please sit with your family to maximize space.

Exit orderly with masks beginning with the back rows using the welcome center exit.

The Welcome Center Rest Rooms will be available for use one person at a time and cleaned in between uses. The Welcome Center, Rest Rooms and Worship Center will be cleaned and disinfected in between worship services.

An offering bucket will be available in the Welcome Center.

**Masks will be required @ 8:00 & recommended @ 11:00.**

Even @ 11:00, PLEASE ENTER AND EXIT WITH A MASK until you are settled at your seat.

If you have a mask, then please bring your own. Those 2 & under should NOT wear a mask.

Masks will be provided for those who do not bring one.

This is in order to be considerate of ALL, especially our seniors, in these unprecedented times.

**Social Distancing will be required in Phase 2. No physical contact.**

Please use wisdom on each row. Large families may take up a whole row. If multiple family units use a row please consider 6 feet for social distancing or mutual consent if not.

**Phase 2—Facility Usage aside from the Worship Services**
