

Galatians 4:8 However at that time, when you did not know God, you were slaves to those which by nature are no gods. 9 But now that you have come to know God, or rather to be known by God, how is it that you turn back again to the weak and worthless elemental things, to which you desire to be enslaved all over again? 10 You observe days and months and seasons and years. 11 I fear for you, that perhaps I have labored over you in vain.


- "To be known by God" reflects sovereign grace.

Galatians 4:12 I beg of you, brethren, become as I am, for I also have become as you are. You have done me no wrong;

 Principle: We must be (model) what we want others to become.





 Paul reveals his personal frustrations reminding them of their shared experience in & for Christ.



Galatians 4:17 They eagerly seek you, not commendably, but they wish to shut you out so that you will seek them. 18 But it is good always to be eagerly sought in a commendable manner, and not only when I am present with you.

- Watch out for separation from the truth.
- Watch out for separation from true brothers and sisters in Christ.

Galatians 4:19 My children, with whom I am again in labor until Christ is formed in you—20 but I could wish to be present with you now and to change my tone, for I am perplexed about you.

 When Christ is really being formed in us, then we will labor with others valuing shared experiences for God's glory.
