- · Paul's close relationship with Epaphras and Epaphras' close relationship with the Colossians is instrumental in the apostle writing this letter of instruction to the church.
- Epaphras is a disciplemaker, a beloved fellow bond-servant, faithful servant and informer.

- · By God's grace, they heard the gospel. Epaphras offered hope.
- · By grace through faith, they responded in initial surrender.
- By grace through faith, the gospel continued to work in them in on-going surrendering.

- The chiastic structure points to the heart of the first part of the prayer of thanksgiving how the gospel has spread throughout the world.
