I want to begin today with a "business meeting" type of update... KNOW that YOU have a voice. Feel free to give me a call on my cell.

In a collaboration with the Stewardship Team, Personnel Team, Pastor Dave Delmotte on behalf of the CCA Board, and Pastor Stan Gibson, the church applied for the payroll protection program through our local bank, Southern Heritage at the amount of \$136,884.00. We are awaiting approval from our bank and the Small Business Administration (SBA). We believe we will soon have the opportunity to receive or decline the loan within a 10 day period. If we receive the funding, we will use it for our church and school employees to meet payroll for an 8 week period. Because we use the funding for payroll, we can then apply for loan forgiveness from the SBA.
