

Many churches are NOT healthy, and churches, in general, struggle to equip people for ministry.


If we make the training of the saints our holy cause, the effect is a healthy church. (Designed to Lead)









Dear to Us: Entrusted Caring



1 Thessalonians 2:1 For you yourselves know, brethren, that our coming to you was not in vain, 2 but after we had already suffered and been mistreated in Philippi, as you know, we had the boldness in our God to speak to you the gospel of God amid much opposition. 3 For our exhortation does not come from error or impurity or by way of deceit; 4 but just as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who examines our hearts.

Dear to Us: Entrusted Caring




1 Thessalonians 2:5 For we never came with flattering speech, as you know, nor with a pretext for greed—God is witness— 6 nor did we seek glory from men, either from you or from others, even though as apostles of Christ we might have asserted our authority. 7 But we proved to be gentle among you, as a nursing mother tenderly cares for her own children. 8 Having so fond an affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become very dear to us.

Charged: To Walk Worthy



1 Thessalonians 2:9 For you recall, brethren, our labor and hardship, how working night and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the gospel of God. 10 You are witnesses, and so is God, how devoutly and uprightly and blamelessly we behaved toward you believers; 11 just as you know how we were exhorting and encouraging and imploring each one of you as a father would his own children, 12 so that you would walk in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.



1 Thessalonians 2:13 For this reason we also constantly thank God that when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men, but for what it really is, the word of God, which also performs its work in you who believe. 14 For you, brethren, became imitators of the churches of God in Christ Jesus that are in Judea, for you also endured the same sufferings at the hands of your own countrymen, even as they did from the Jews, 15 who both killed the Lord Jesus and the prophets, and drove us out. They are not pleasing to God, but hostile to all men, 16 hindering us from speaking to the Gentiles so that they may be saved; with the result that they always fill up the measure of their sins. But wrath has come upon them to the utmost.

When we receive (believe/trust) The Word of God, it is much more than the word(s) of men...IT IS THE powerful WORD OF GOD.


God and His Word have the greatest capacity to change our lives. Transformation comes from God's Word doing a work in us.

Real Church Growth is powered by the gospel (Word), not relevance.




Acts 20:32 And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

1 Peter 1:22 Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love one another from the heart, 23 for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring word of God.



- 1 Thessalonians 1:6 You also became imitators of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much tribulation with the joy of the Holy Spirit, 7 so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:14 For you, brethren, became <u>imitators</u> of the <u>churches</u> of God in Christ Jesus that are in Judea, for you also <u>endured the same sufferings</u> at the hands of your own countrymen, even as they did from the Jews, 15 who both <u>killed</u> the Lord Jesus and the prophets, and drove us out. They are not pleasing to God, but **hostile** to all men,

The focus of affirmation was on their faith, love & hope in suffering.

"God's Church must make it a critical priority to train leaders to create and shape cultures where people flourish and the gospel is advanced." (Designed to Lead)


