

1 Thes. 3:1 Therefore when we could endure it no longer, we thought it best to be left behind at Athens alone, 2 and we sent Timothy, our brother and God's fellow worker in the gospel of Christ, to strengthen and encourage you as to your faith, 3 so that no one would be disturbed by these afflictions; for you yourselves know that we have been destined for this. 4 For indeed when we were with you, we kept telling you in advance that we were going to suffer affliction; and so it came to pass, as you know. 5 For this reason, when I could endure it no longer, I also sent to find out about your faith, for fear that the tempter might have tempted you, and our labor would be in vain.

James 2:14 What use is it, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but he has no works? Can that faith save him? 15 If a brother or sister is without clothing and in need of daily food, 16 and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and be filled," and yet you do not give them what is necessary for their body, what use is that? 17 Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, being by itself. Thankful, Joyful, Prayerful

- 1 Thessalonians **3:9** For what **thanks** can we render to God for you in return for all the **joy** with which we rejoice before our God on your account, **10** as we night and day keep **praying** most earnestly that we may see your face, and may complete what is lacking in **your faith**?
- The writers are thanking God and praying to God for them.
- The writers worked night and day so they wouldn't be a financial burden (2:9) and prayed night and day so their faith would grow and so they would be fit for ministry.



Faith-filled prayer lifts our eyes from ourselves to God's agenda & our heart to work alongside of Him.

Practice a regular pattern of prayer, for example,

Thanksgiving

Supplication
