June 13 Ch. 6 Evangelism Is An Announcement of Good News

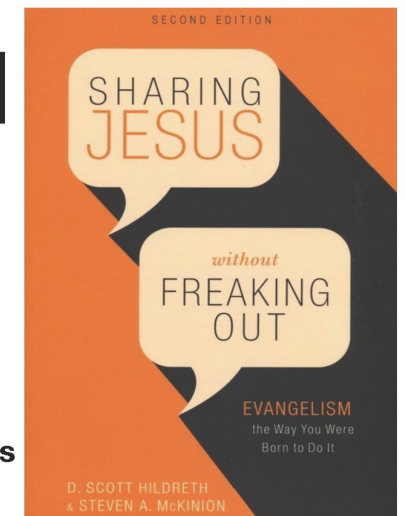
Principle: People are already interested in what is best for them, the gospel is best for all people.
