Jesus modeled being a disciple/disciplemaker.

Jesus mandated disciplinmaking.

Jesus gave the method for disciplinmaking.

Disciplinmaking is done...

- by someone, not by something.
- by persons, not programs.
- by man, not materials.
- by individuals, not by institutions.

Jesus was the greatest  
disciplemaker of all time.
