The recorded history of Jesus is similar to national history of Israel... first we see how Jesus went to Egypt and came back under the leadership of God.

Hosea 11:1 When Israel was a youth I loved him,  
**And out of Egypt I called My son.**

Matthew 2:16 Then when **Herod** saw that he had been tricked by the magi, he **became very enraged, and sent and slew all the male children who were in Bethlehem** and all its vicinity, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had determined from the magi. 17 Then what had been spoken through Jeremiah the prophet was **fulfilled**:  
18 "A voice was heard in Ramah, Weeping and great mourning, Rachel weeping for her children; & she refused to be comforted, Because they were no more."

The recorded history of Jesus is similar to the national history of Israel... second we see grieving mothers over the grisly murders of infants in Bethlehem and the grieving over exiled children during the Babylonian captivity.

Jeremiah 31:15 Thus says the Lord, "A voice is heard in Ramah,

Because they are no more."
