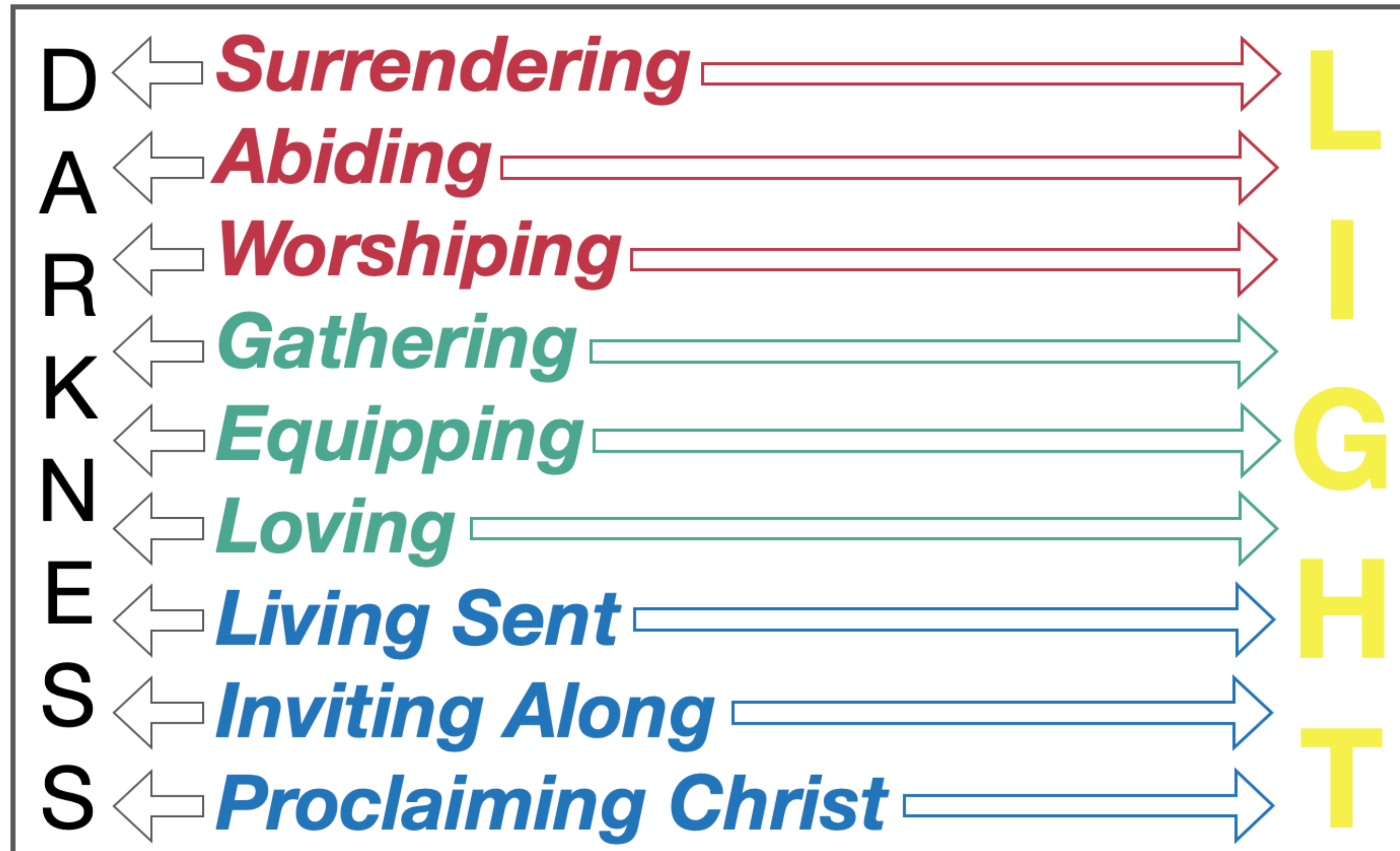
24 The Lord bless you, and keep you;

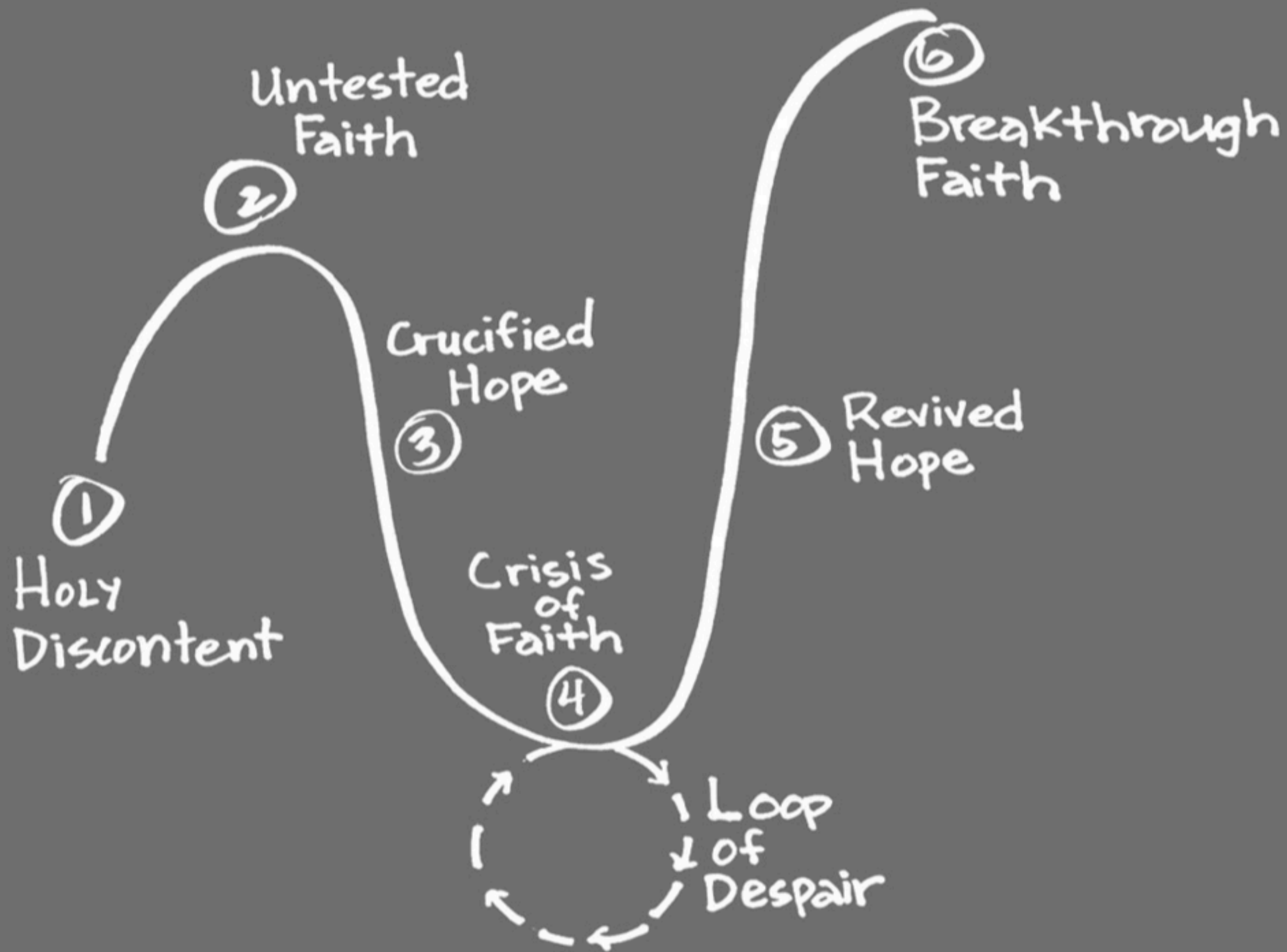
25 The Lord make His face shine on you,

Numbers 7:1 Now on the day that Moses had finished setting up **the tabernacle**, he **anointed** it and **consecrated** it with all its furnishings and the altar and all its utensils; he **anointed** them and **consecrated** them also. 2 Then **the leaders** of Israel, **the heads** of their fathers' households, made an **offering** (they were **the leaders** of the tribes; they were the ones who were over the numbered men).

- The (mobile) tabernacle was a tent of meeting (with God).
- Moses anointed & consecrated it as a DEDICATION.
- The leader's offering showed it was a tabernacle for ALL.

Numbers 7:3 When **they brought their offering before the Lord**, six covered carts and twelve oxen, a cart for every two of the leaders and an ox for each one, then **they presented them before the tabernacle**. 4 Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 5 “Accept these things from them, that they may be used in the service of the tent of meeting, and you shall give them to the Levites, to each man according to his service.”

I pray that what is “before us” is “before the Lord.”

Carts: Van Capital Campaign

Dedication: Used for our INTENDED PURPOSE (in His service).

Numbers 7:6 So Moses took the carts and the oxen and gave them to the Levites. 7 Two carts and four oxen he gave to the sons of Gershon, according to their service, 8 and four carts and eight oxen he gave to the sons of Merari, according to their service, under the direction of Ithamar the son of Aaron the priest. 9 But he did not give any to the sons of Kohath because theirs was the service of the holy objects, which they carried on the shoulder.

- The gifts met needs created by the Levite job description.
- Each tribe was different in number, and they all played a valuable and important role in carrying out the mission.

Numbers 7:10 **The leaders offered the dedication offering for the altar when it was anointed, so the leaders offered their offering before the altar.**

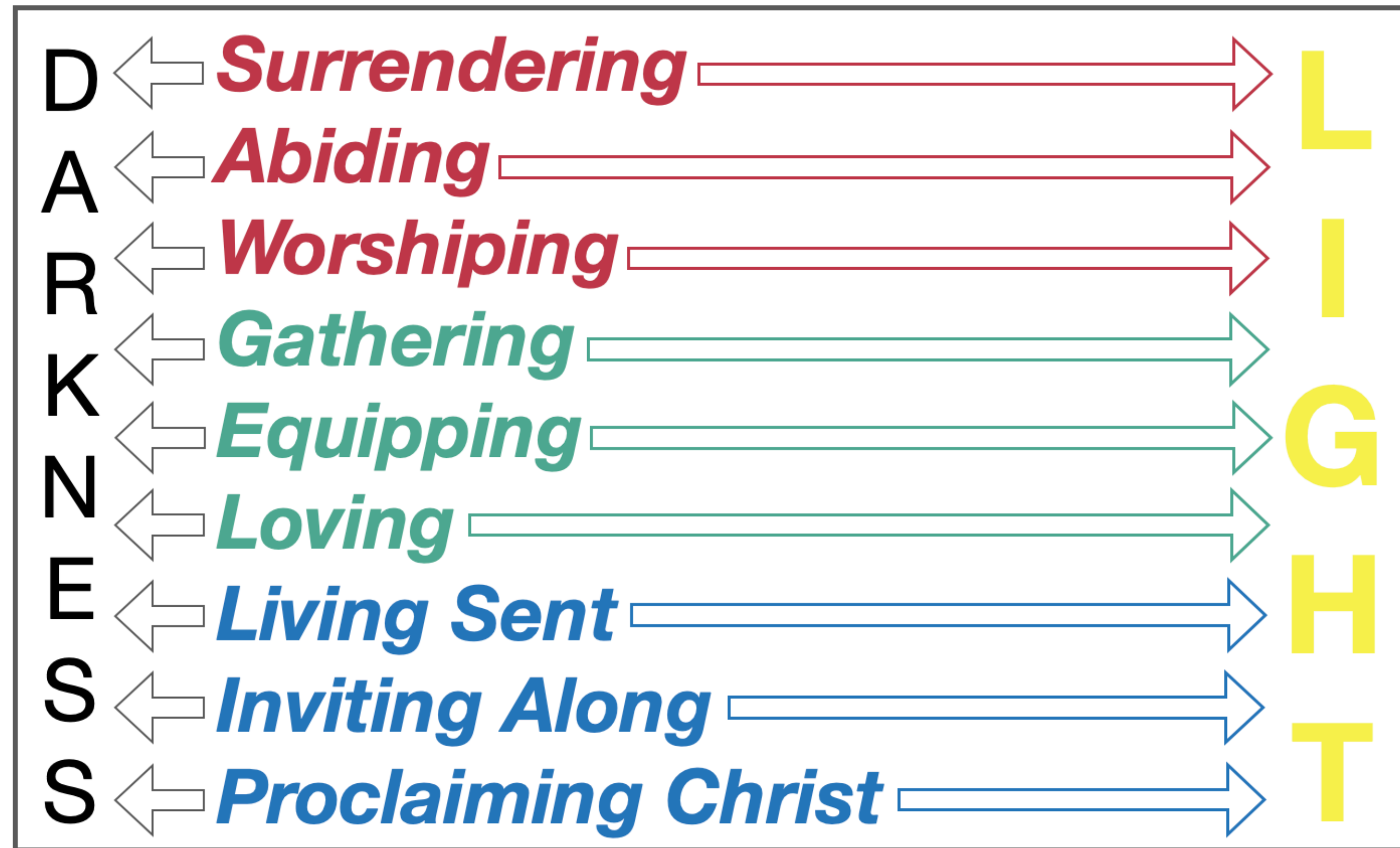
11 Then the Lord said to Moses, “Let them present their offering, one leader each day, for the dedication of **the altar.**”

- Dedication utilizes the altar and a posture of surrender.
- (This isn't the 12 Days of Christmas.). However, a leader from a different tribe makes the same offering each day.
