Our One-of-a-Kind Life 1. Who We Were (1-3)

- >WE WERE DEAD!
- > Spiritually Lifeless
- "They are darkened in their understanding, ALIENATED FROM THE LIFE OF GOD because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart." (Ephesians 4:18)

Our One-of-a-Kind Life 1. Who We Were (1-3)

Spiritual death is ALIENATION from the life source of God through the vine of Jesus Christ.

- ➤ If we are to minister out of our one-of-akind life, we must remember that the person we are ministering to was once us.

2. Who We Are (4-9).

- > BUT GOD...restores life to the spiritually dead.
- > What is the motivation of God to give life? It is LOVE!
- That means that God has done what we could never do on our own, and contrary to nature, He has saved us by grace through our response of faith to His call of salvation.

Our One-of-a-Kind Life 3. Who We Are to Be (10)

➤ God, in Christ Jesus, has strategically made us new for the purpose of doing good works to display the glory of God's work in saving sinners.

Ephesians 4:15-16

"Rather speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when EACH PART IS WORKING PROPERLY, MAKES THE BODY GROW SO THAT IT BUILDS ITSELF UP IN LOVE."

3. Who We Are to Be (10)

- > Application
- ➤ Identify difficult experiences in your life that you have gone through, the counsel from God's Word and through God's people that helped you through that journey.
- ➤ Identify the blessings in your life, and recognize how they have shaped who you are today in order to be freed to be a minister of encouragement today.

3. Who We Are to Be (10)

> Take note of who God has put around you right now in your sphere of life, and pray asking God to teach you how to LOVE them, in order that you may KNOW them better, so that you can SPEAK the Word of God into their life, and DO what good works that need to be done in order to minister to their needs.
