My Covenant I Will Not Violate

When I say...
there is a God.
Then you say...
and I am NOT Him.

There was a pre-incarnation people. There was an incarnation group. There is a post-incarnation people. The King is coming again.

Gospel Definition (today's emphasis is on KING JESUS)

The holy, creator GOD

was confronted with MAN's rebellion and sin.

So, JESUS has chosen in love to become the redeemer and restorer of man to God and God's purposes

made possible by grace through faith and SURRENDER to the crucified, risen **King**.

Leviticus 26:44 Yet in spite of this, when they are in the land of their enemies, I will not reject them, nor will I so abhor them as to destroy them, breaking My covenant with them; for I am the Lord their God. 45 But I will remember for them the covenant with their ancestors, whom I brought out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations, that I might be their God. I am the Lord."

King Jesus: God created a people through whom the Messiah would come. 2 Samuel 7:13 He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. 14 I will be a father to him and he will be a son to Me; when he commits iniquity, I will correct him with the rod of men and the strokes of the sons of men, 15 but My lovingkindness shall not depart from him, as I took it away from Saul, whom I removed from before you. 16 Your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever."" 17 In accordance with all these words and all this vision, so Nathan spoke to David.

Psalm 89:19 Once You spoke in vision to Your godly ones, And said, "I have given help to one who is mighty; I have exalted one chosen from the people.

20 "I have found David My servant;
With My holy oil I have anointed him,
21 With whom My hand will be established;
My arm also will strengthen him.
22 "The enemy will not deceive him,
Nor the son of wickedness afflict him.

Psalm 89:23 "But I shall crush his adversaries before him, And strike those who hate him.

24 "My faithfulness and My lovingkindness will be with him,
And in My name his horn will be exalted.

25 "I shall also set his hand on the sea
And his right hand on the rivers.

Psalm 89:26 "He will cry to Me, 'You are my Father, My God, and the rock of my salvation.'
27 "I also shall make him My firstborn, The highest of the kings of the earth.
28 "My lovingkindness I will keep for him forever,"

And My covenant shall be confirmed to him.

29 "So I will establish his descendants forever

And his throne as the days of heaven.

Psalm 89:30 "If his sons forsake My law
And do not walk in My judgments,
31 If they violate My statutes
And do not keep My commandments,
32 Then I will punish their transgression with the rod
And their iniquity with stripes.

"But I will not break off My lovingkindness from him, Nor deal falsely in My faithfulness.

Psalm 89:34 "My covenant I will not violate, Nor will I alter the utterance of My lips. 35 "Once I have sworn by My holiness; I will not lie to David. 36 "His descendants shall endure forever And his throne as the sun before Me. "It shall be established forever like the moon, And the witness in the sky is faithful." Selah.

Luke 1:30 The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary; for you have found favor with God. 31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus. 32 He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David; 33 and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will have no end."

Mark 1:14 Now after John had been taken into custody,
Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God,
15 and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of
God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."

- 1. All of history was working toward this time.
- 2. The day had come for foggy hope to become brighter.
- 3. Jesus was announcing He was here as the King of kings.

Luke 17:20 Now having been questioned by the Pharisees as to when the kingdom of God was coming, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God is not coming with signs to be observed; 21 nor will they say, 'Look, here it is!' or, 'There it is!' For behold, the kingdom of God is in your midst."

- 1. Jesus was saying the kingdom of God was near.
- 2. Jesus brought the power & glory of His kingdom with Him.

1 Peter 5:8 Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. 9 But resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world. 10 After you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you. 11 To Him be dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 19:6 Then I heard something like the voice of a great multitude and like the sound of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, saying, "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns. Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready." 8 It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.
