Psalm 31:14 But as for me, I trust in You, O Lord,
I say, "You are my God."

15 My times are in Your hand;
Deliver me from the hand of my enemies and from those who
persecute me.

16 Make Your face to shine upon Your servant;
Save me in Your lovingkindness.

17 Let me not be put to shame, O Lord, for I call upon You;
Let the wicked be put to shame, let them be silent in Sheol.

18 Let the lying lips be mute,
Which speak arrogantly against the righteous
With pride and contempt.

Psalm 31:19 **How great is Your goodness,**
Which You have stored up for those who fear You,
Which You have wrought for those who take refuge in You,
Before the sons of men!
20 You hide them in the secret place of Your presence from
the conspiracies of man;
You keep them secretly in a shelter from the strife of tongues.
21 Blessed be the Lord,
For **He has made marvelous His lovingkindness** to me in a
besieged city.
22 As for me, I said in my alarm,
“I am cut off from before Your eyes”;
Nevertheless You heard the voice of my supplications
When I cried to You.

Psalm 31:23 O love the Lord, all you His godly ones!
The Lord preserves the faithful
And fully recompenses the proud doer.

24 Be strong and let your heart take courage,
All you who hope in the Lord.

Psalm 31:16a Make Your face to shine upon Your servant;

2 Cor. 3:17 Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. 18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.



Glory: Worship God anywhere and everywhere
in all things

Psalm 31:21b ... He has made marvelous His lovingkindness

2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ controls us, having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all died; 15 and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf.

Jesus redeemed us by bearing our sins in His death
on the cross, overcoming evil.

The resurrected **Jesus** restores us to new life for God's glory
and God's purposes.



Gospel: **Grace** for new birth & new lifestyle

Psalm 31:24a Be strong and let your heart take courage,

2 Cor. 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day. 17 For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison, 18 while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.
